

SLEEPING BAG


YOU WILL NEED

- A piece of coloured A5 paper
- A piece of paper for the head
- An ice-cream stick
- Collage materials
- Glue
- Coloured felt-tipped markers, pencils or crayons

STEPS:

- Fold the A5 paper up from the short end so it is nearly in half.
- Pold the A5 paper in at each side and glue at the back to make a sleeping bag.
- Use the collage materials and coloured markers, pencils or crayons to decorate your sleeping bag.
- 4 Cut out a head from the other piece of paper, draw on some eyes and use some collage material for hair.
- Stick the paper head to the end of the ice-cream stick to make a person.
- 6 Insert the person into the sleeping bag.


Sleep tight!
